



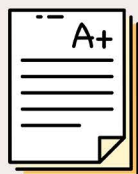

Passage of the CPA Exam



EXAMINATION

To qualify for the CPA Exam, applicants must first satisfy the requirements in the Education box.

Two Years of General Accounting Experience

24 months of experience obtained through Employment/ Internship/Volunteering in public or non-public accounting.

- Obtained under the supervision of an individual holding an active CPA license.



EXPERIENCE

Attest Engagements:

To be issued a license with the ability to sign reports on attest engagements, you must also complete a minimum of 500 hours in attest experience.

(Experience in academia can be considered qualifying if specific requirements are met.)

EDUCATION

Bachelor's Degree in any subject.

Accounting Concentration of Courses

- 24** Accounting Units
- 24** Business (or additional Accounting Units)
- 3** Ethics Units

Amount listed in semester units



CBA "recognized" bachelor's or advanced degrees fully meet all educational requirements.

CPA LICENSURE

Additional options to satisfy portions of the Education and Experience requirements.

Obtain an Advanced Degree in Accounting or Related Subject:

- Substitutes for 12 months of Experience

OR

Obtain a CBA-Recognized Certificate:

- Satisfies the Accounting Concentration of Courses
- Substitutes for 6 months of Experience
